Dear Craftspeople,

The 65th Annual Hebron Church Fair, which is always held on the the last Saturday in July, is scheduled this year for Saturday, July 29, 2017. This is your invitation to apply. If you are a new vendor, please submit photos of your work with your application. We ask that new vendors make most or all of what they sell. We are currently limiting the number of new jewelers and fabric craft vendors, soap vendors, fudge vendors, and maple syrup vendors because we have the maximum that our fair can accomodate. However, if you make something that you think is unique, or if we get cancellations from prior vendors, we would consider adding more of these crafts. The decision for space availability for new vendors is not made until after the deadline of May 1st, as returning vendors have priority for sites.

The terms are as follows: the cost to participants is 25% of sales; the non-refundable deposit of **\$35.00** per space will be credited towards the 25% settlement. **Please note that we have increased our non-refundable deposit this year to \$35.00.** If you are a local Non-Profit organization, approved by us, your fee is limited to the initial **\$35.00** registration fee. We urge you to register early as space is limited. Previous participants who sign up by **May 1** will have priority. After that date, spaces will be assigned on a first-received basis. **Please also note that we will be adhering to our May 1 date as the interest in our fair has increased and we want to let new vendors know as soon as possible that they will be included in our fair.** We will not be able to add additional spaces this year, so please get your applications in early. All proceeds from the Fair will be used for the important work of the Church.

Fair setup begins at 7:00 AM, with the opening at 9:00 AM. Friday setup between 4pm-7pm can be arranged with prior notice. The Fair continues through the barbeque at 5:30 PM. We ask craftspeople to remain until 4:00 PM.

Please note: We received complaints in the past from both vendors and customers concerning dogs. If you plan to bring your dog, please be prepared to clean up after them.
